
Land Disturbance Permit Flow Chart

Prepare Major Land Disturbance Permit Application.

The following 3 Plans must be submitted with the Application.

- 1. Stormwater Management Plan
- 2. Erosion & Sediment Control Plan (include O&M Plan for Temporary BMPs)
- **3. Stormwater Management O&M Plan** (for Permanent BMPs)

During Construction

Perform required inspections.

Project Completion

Submit Final Report and as-builts to (INSERT AEA) for approval. AEA issues certification letter to be submitted by Owner to Building Inspector to receive a Certificate of Occupancy.

Post Construction

Update O&M Plan (for Permanent BMPs) once per year and maintain log of inspections and maintenance.

Construction **Project Begins.**

Stormwater
Management
Permit expires 1
Year from date of approval.

Once application is approved, Stormwater Management Permit is issued.

For land disturbances ≥ 1 Acre, must also have permit coverage under EPA's NPDES Construction General Permit. Submit copy of approved EPA NOI to DPW to obtain Stormwater Management Permit.


Submit Application Package (1 Hard and 1 Electronic) to Department of Public Works. Include Fee.
